Important Notes:

1. "Six- days in a week for teaching" to be followed.
2. Academic calendar and dates are subject to revision due to prevailing orders of the competent authorities.
3. Conduction of classes, exams and assessments are proposed to be done through the Offline (Pen & Paper)/ Online/Blended (Online & Offline) or any appropriate mode, and that should be as per the guidelines issued by the respective regulatory bodies/ government departments from time to time.
4. #Institutes/UTDs can have flexibility in dates of Practical and Viva-Voce Exams however it should be scheduled within the specified dates/duration.



5. *Theory Exams of the Final Semesters of all the programmes to be scheduled early on-priority, in order to declare the Final Semester Results at the earliest possible.
6. **RESULTS of all semesters will be declared within ten days of the last paper of a particular programme of a particular semester, and for this VALUATION WORK should be done simultaneously during the exams so that it is completed within three days of the last paper.
7. Exam Time-Tables for the Internal Assessment Exams (I & II), the concerned college/UTD has to organise and conduct the Exams within the specified dates/duration. Time-Tables for these exams also to be notified by the concerned college/UTD. End-Sem. College Exam (if any) to be appropriately Scheduled and conducted by the College.
8. Depending on monthly progress of syllabus completion, Extra-Classes should be organized by respective department during off days/off time.
9. Academic Activities: Keeping the above time-frame in view, respective institutes/departments may schedule the dates (as convenient) for the Conferences, Seminars, Workshops or Other Academic Activities like Industrial Visits, Training, and CNE/CME/FDPs etc.
10. Internships/Trainings for the students, should be planned during the semester-breaks by the concerned Departments (Principals/HODs/Professors).
11. Programmes (U.G. / P.G./ Diploma) having Annual-Exam-System/Professional System will follow separate Academic Calendar.
