- 2. Academic calendar and dates are subject to revision due to prevailing orders of the competent authorities.
- 3. Conduction of classes, exams and assessments are proposed to be done through the Offline (Pen & Paper)/ Online/Blended (Online or Offline) or any appropriate mode, and that should be as per the guidelines issued by the respective regulatory bodies/ government departments from time to time.
- 4. "Institutes/UTDs can have flexibility in scheduling the batch-wise Practical and Viva-Voce Exams, but it should be conducted within the Specified dates/duration.
- 5. *Theory Exams of the Final Professional of all the programmes to be scheduled early on-priority, in order to declare the Final Results at the earliest.
- 6. **RESULTS of all Professionals will be declared within ten days of the last paper of a particular programme, and for this VALUATION WORK should be done simultaneously during the exams so that valuation work is completed within three days of the last paper.
- 7. Exam Time-Tables for the Sessional Exams (I & II) and Pre University Exams, the concerned College has to organise and conduct the Exams within the specified dates/duration. Time-Tables for these exams also to be notified by the concerned College.
- 8. Depending upon monthly progress of syllabus completion, Extra-Classes should be organized by respective department during off days/off time.
- 9. Academic Activities: Keeping the above time-frame in view, respective institutes/departments may schedule the dates (as convenient) for the Conferences, Seminars, Workshops or Other Academic Activities like Industrial Visits, Training, and FDPs etc.
- 10. Internships/Trainings for the students, should be planned during the breaks by the concerned Departments (Principals/HODs/Professor).
- 11. Programmes (U.G./P.G./Diploma) having annual-exam-system/semester system will follow separate academic calendar.
- 12. The Schedule/dates are subject to revision.
