A Score of less than 3 in any of above items will be considered as unsatisfactory completion of internship. In case the candidate does not complete the internship satisfactorily, he/she shall have to repeat the internship.

10. The medium of instruction and examination shall be English
11. The amount of examination fee to be paid by regular/re appear candidate for each part shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time.
12. A candidate must pass the whole course including internship within a period of ten years of his /her admission to the first year of Pharm.D course failing which he/she will be required to repeat the whole course denovo.
Provided that the period of the whole course of Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate) including internship shall be six years of his/her admission to the first year of Pharm.D (Post Baccalaureate).
13. The minimum marks required to pass the examinations Shall be asunder:-
(i) 50% marks in each of the theory subjects including sessional marks.
(ii) 50% marks in each of the practical examinations including sessional marks.
14. The successful candidates of Part- I/II/III/IV/V/VI shall be classified and the division obtained by the candidate will be stated in his/her Pharm.D degree, asunder:-

01	Those who obtain 75% marks or above in any subject (S)	First Class with Distinction in the subject(s)
02	Those who obtain 60% marks or above in aggregate all subjects in a single attempt	First Class.
03	Those who obtain 50% marks or above in aggregate in all subjects.	Second Class

15. The Vice Chancellor shall award one grace marks to the candidate who is either failing or missing the division by one mark. However, it will not be added anywhere.
16. After the termination of the examination, the Controller of Examinations shall publish the result of the candidates and issue Detailed-Marks-Cards as expeditiously as possible.

Chirayu University, Bhopal**Ordinance No. 65****Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.)/ Master of Chirurgie (M.Ch.)****1. Focus and Goal:**

The focus and goal of D.M./M.Ch. super speciality medical education is to produce competent specialist and medical teachers recognized by the fraternity as the graduating scholars, building upon their postgraduate education and skills who shall:

- a. Recognize the health needs of the community and carry out professional obligations ethically keeping in view the objectives of the national health policy;
- b. Have mastered most of the competencies, pertaining to the respective speciality, that is required to be practiced at the secondary and the tertiary levels of the health care delivery system;
- c. Be aware of the contemporary advancements and developments in the respective discipline concerned and shall progress accordingly;
- d. Have acquired a spirit of scientific inquiry and is oriented to the principles of research methodology and epidemiology;
- e. Have acquired the basic skills in the teaching of medical professionals;
- f. Acquire basic management skills in human resources, materials and resource management related to health care delivery, general hospital management, principal inventory skills and counselling;
- g. Develop personal characteristics and attitudes required for professional life such as personal integrity, sense of responsibility and dependability and ability to relate to or show concern for other individuals;
- h. Become an exemplary citizen by observing the highest standards of professional ethics and working towards fulfilling social and professional obligations to respond to national aspirations.

2. **Definitions** – In this ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires the terms defined herein shall bear the meaning assigned to them below and their cognate expressions and variations shall be construed accordingly –

- a. **"NEET-SS"** shall mean "National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test" for super-speciality courses.
 - b. **"Feeder Speciality"** shall mean broad-speciality qualification required to pursue course of qualification.
3. **Programme: Programme of study leading to award of degree of Doctorate of Medicine (D.M.) in super-specialities:** Cardiac Anaesthesia/ Cardiology/ Child and Adolescent Psychiatry/ Clinical Haematology/ Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology/ Clinical Pharmacology/ Critical Care Medicine/ Endocrinology/ Geriatric Mental Health/ Hepatology/ Infectious Disease/ Interventional Radiology/ Medical Gastroenterology/ Medical Genetics/ Medical Oncology/ Neonatology/ Nephrology/ Neuro-Anaesthesia/ Neurology/ Neuro-radiology/ Onco-Pathology/ Organ Transplant Anaesthesia and Critical Care/ Paediatric and Neonatal Anaesthesia/ Paediatric Cardiology/ Paediatric Critical Care/ Paediatric Gastroenterology/ Paediatric Hepatology/ Paediatric Nephrology/ Paediatric Neurology/ Paediatric Oncology/ Pulmonary Medicine/ Virology; **or Master of Chirurgie (M.Ch.)** in Endocrine Surgery/ Gynaecological Oncology/ Hand Surgery/ Head and Neck Surgery/ Hepato-Pancreato-Biliary-Surgery/ Neurosurgery/ Paediatric Cardio Thoracic Vascular Surgery/ Paediatric Orthopaedics/ Paediatric Surgery/ Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery/ Reproductive Medicine and Surgery/ Surgical Gastroenterology/ Surgical Oncology/ Urology/ Vascular Surgery/ Cardio Vascular/ Thoracic Surgery or any other super-specialities as approved by NMC from time to time.
4. **Admission and Eligibility:**
- a. Admission to D.M./M.Ch. course shall be as per prevailing norms and guidelines of NMC/any other body/organization so designated by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India.
 - b. The eligibility to pursue a super-speciality programme/course in Medicine shall be by securing the minimum eligible score at the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test-Super-Speciality (NEET-SS) conducted either by the National Medical Commission or caused to have been conducted by the National Medical Commission or as may be decided by NMC from time to time.

- c. The feeder broad Speciality qualifications required to pursue a super-speciality course of recognized super-speciality qualification shall be as per Post-Graduate Medical Education Regulations – 2023 (PGMER-23) and further amendments/revisions thereof as approved from time to time.
 - d. Last date of admission shall be as notified by NMC/NTA or any agency on its behalf.
 - e. Admission of Foreign Nationals/NRI/PIO shall be as per policy/rules as applicable.
5. **Reservation of Seats:** The reservation of seats for respective categories shall be as per applicable laws prevailing in Madhya Pradesh.
6. **Training:**
- a. The period of training for the award of various post-graduate degrees in super-speciality shall be 03 Years (including period of examination).
 - b. All students shall work as full time residents during the period of training, attending not less than 80% (Eighty percent) of the training during each calendar year, and given full time responsibility and participation in all facets of the educational process.
 - c. The training programmes shall be updated as and when required while keeping in mind the curriculum requirements and other relevant requirements prescribed by PGMEB from time to time.
7. **Curriculum:** The curriculum shall be as recommended by the Post-graduate Medical Education Board on behalf of NMC which shall form the base for the development of a detailed medical curriculum by concerned Board of Studies and the same shall be implemented with the approval of Academic Council of University.
8. **Examinations:** The medical college/institution/UTD will conduct the Formative Assessment (examination) and the University will conduct the Summative Assessment (examination). Both Formative Assessment (examination) and Summative Assessment (examination) shall consist of Theory, Clinical/Practical and Viva Voce.

8.1 Examiners:

- a. The examiner (both internal and external) for the post-graduate examination in Super Specialties shall have three years' experience as recognized Post-graduate Guide in the concerned subject.
- b. The minimum number of examiners for post-graduate examination shall be four. Out of which, at least two shall be external examiners and least one of them shall be from different university outside the state.
- c. The Head of the department of the institution concerned shall be one of the internal examiners and second internal examiner shall rotate after every two year.
- d. An examiner shall not be appointed for more than two consecutive regular examinations of the University.

8.2 Methodology: The Examination shall consist of theory and clinical/practical and viva voce.

- a. Theory: The theory examination (both formative and summative) may be of descriptive answer of a question type, Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) type or mix of both types. Theory examination for summative examination shall be of four theory papers. The first and the fourth paper shall be on basic medical science and recent advances, respectively. The theory examination shall be held well in advance before the clinical and practical examination.
- b. Clinical/Practical and viva voce:
 - i. Clinical examination for the subjects in clinical sciences shall be conducted to test the knowledge and competence of the candidates for undertaking independent work as a consultant/specialist/teacher, for which candidates shall be examined for one long case and two short cases.
 - ii. Practical examination may consist of carrying out special investigative techniques for Diagnosis and Therapy. M.Ch. candidates shall also be examined in surgical procedures. Viva voce examination shall be comprehensive enough to test the candidate's overall knowledge and competence about the subject, investigative procedures, therapeutic technique and other aspects of the Speciality.
 - iii. Clinical/practical examination shall include Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE).

8.3 Valuation:

- a. All the teachers of the University or other Universities, who are eligible to be post-graduate examiners, can perform the valuation of the answer scripts.
- b. All the answer scripts shall be subjected for two valuations by the concerned University. The average of the total marks awarded by the two valuers for the paper, which is rounded off to the nearest integer (whole number), shall be considered for computation of the results. All the answer scripts, where the difference between two valuations is 15% and more of the total marks prescribed for the paper, shall be subjected to third valuation. The average of the best two total marks, awarded by the three evaluators for the paper, rounded off to the nearest integer (whole number), shall be considered for final computation of the results.
- c. After the computation and declaration of the results, under no circumstances, revaluation is permitted

9. Guide:

The academic qualification and teaching experience required for recognition by University as a guide for dissertation work shall be as per NMC. A faculty member in a medical institution shall be eligible to be designated as a Postgraduate Guide in a super speciality if such member possesses at least three years of teaching experience in the respective super speciality as an Assistant Professor or above.

A Co-guide may be included provided the work requires substantial contribution from a sister department or from another medical institution recognized for teaching/training by NMC. The Co guide shall be a recognized postgraduate teacher.

9.1 Change of Guide:

In the event of a registered guide leaving the college for any reason or in the event of death of guide, guide may be changed with prior permission from the University

10. Cancellation of Admission:

The admission of the student at any stage of the study shall be cancelled by the Vice Chancellor based on the recommendation of the head of the institution if:

- a. He/She is found to have produced false / forged documents or found to have used unfair means to secure admission.
- b. He/She is found to be involved in serious breach of discipline in the institution or the University campus.

11. The provisions of this ordinance are based on Post-Graduate Medical Education Regulations – 2023 (PGMER-23) published by National Medical Commission (NMC), amendments/revision thereof shall be implemented as approved from time to time.

12. General: Notwithstanding anything stated in this Ordinance, for any unforeseen issues arising, and not covered by this Ordinance, or in the event of differences of interpretation, the Vice Chancellor may take a decision after obtaining, if necessary, the opinion / advice of a committee consisting of any or all the Dean/ Director/ Principal/ Head of Department/ Institutions / Constituent College/ Schools. The decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final.
