5. \*Theory Exams of the Final Year of all the programmes to be scheduled early on-priority, in order to declare the Final Year Results at the earliest possible.
6. **\*\*RESULTS of Main Exams are desired to be declared within ten days of the last paper and for this VALUATION WORK should be done simultaneously during the exams so that it is completed within three days of the last paper.**
7. Exam Time-Tables for the Internal Assessment Exams (I, II & III), the concerned College has to organise and conduct the Exams within the specified dates/duration. Time-Tables for these exams also to be notified by the concerned College.
8. Depending on monthly progress of syllabus completion, Extra-Classes should be organized by respective department during off days/off time.
9. Academic Activities: Keeping the above time-frame in view, respective institutes/departments may schedule the dates (as convenient) for the Conferences, Seminars, Workshops or Other Academic Activities like Industrial Visits, Training, and CNE/CME/FDPs etc.
